Problem

C380 users & service personnel are experiencing extreme difficulty in removing the rear housing.

Solution

A procedure has been implemented on the proper opening technique to remove the rear housing.

Field Service Action

Customer Returns:


Use the following procedure to remove the rear housing as necessary on customer returns. Refer to the diagram below.

- 1) Squeeze the sides of the front housing in the middle of the "Motorola" logo as shown in the diagram;
- 2) Simultaneously press the release button on the top of the phone with the thumb of your free hand;
- 3) While implementing Steps 1 and 2, pull the rear housing away from the phone.
