## **Problem**

Service is aware of an issue identified by software engineering, where customer complains of "Accessory - Memory Card, unknown files".

The "app\_dump" folder with files under the folder was observed by end users on memory card. The root cause of this issue is due to a debug feature which was enabled that allowed Core dump files to be created on SD card for each occurrence of an application crash.



## <u>Solution</u>

<u>Short term:</u> Remove the files in app\_dump directory on memory card follow the steps: For CMCC software version:

go to My favorites --> go to Memory Card --> highlight app\_dump folder --> press left soft key " Option" --> select "Delete" --> click "Yes"

For other regions software version(which has the file manager under office tools):

Go to Menu--> select office tools--> select File manager -->then select Memory card -->then go app\_dump folder --> select options then Delete it

Long term: This FSB will be revised with the SW version which prevents any coredumps to be created on consumer phones.
